What is Kinship? - Kinship Care is the full time parenting of children and youth by relative (grandparents, or other biological relatives) and Non-Related Extended Family Member (NREFM) caregivers. **Eligibility has been expanded** to include services to licensed foster parents for the purpose of Foster Parent Recruitment, Resource Family Home (RFH), Retention and Support (FPRS), Foster Family Agencies (FFA) are not applicable for this program. These loving and caring FPRS individuals step in when parents are unable to care for their children because of a variety of circumstances or situations. The Kinship Support Services Program provides many supportive services for these caregivers and children to help strengthen their families and to provide opportunities for success.
